Justice4Yemen Pact

The Justice4Yemen Pact Coalition commends the steps taken by the local committee of the mediation initiative and local authorities to open the road connecting the governorates of Marib, Al-Bayda, and Sana'a. We welcome this positive development, which benefits Yemeni citizens and alleviates their suffering.

Opening the main roads in Yemen is vital to facilitate the movement of citizens and goods and to provide essential services to people in internationally recognized Government areas. Yemeni people have suffered from the ravages of war, blockades, and insecurity for many years, which has increased their hardship and deprived them of their most basic rights to movement, healthcare, education, food, and fuel.

Therefore, the Justice4Yemen Coalition calls for the opening of the main Marib - Fardat Nihm - Sana'a road, which is the closest link between Marib and Sana'a, taking only two and a half hours to traverse. This road will save travelers from the long and arduous desert route, protecting them from potential violations and risks.

Opening this vital road will facilitate the movement of citizens and goods, help deliver essential services to Internationally recognized government areas, and alleviate the suffering of civilians who have long endured the horrors of war, blockades, and forced displacement. This measure will also enhance trust between the conflicting parties and represents a positive step towards achieving peace and stability in Yemen.

Therefore, the Justice4Yemen Coalition urges all concerned parties to commit to this positive step and to overcome any obstacles that may hinder the opening of this vital road, to safeguard the rights of Yemeni citizens and reduce their long-standing humanitarian suffering.
